CONNECT and LEARN Financial Peace University

Financial Peace University has been transforming lives across our synod. For the past several rounds, FPU has been offered to **our pastors and deacons** — walking together through the practical realities of budgeting and debt alongside our deeper relationship with money, stewardship, and trust. The 83 who've completed the class have paid off \$341,850 and saved \$526,113 collectively — real signs of transformation. Now, the whole synod community is invited to join. Sessions begin September 18, 11 am–12:15 pm or 4–5:15 pm. This will be the last round offered for a while, so if you've been meaning to join, this is your chance.

And **if you're a lay leader**, we'd love for you to join Bishop Foster for a Lay Leader Lunch Hour. We'll pray together and spend an hour in conversation about whatever's on your mind — theological questions, governance issues, anything at all. These classes begin September 12 and run for five weeks

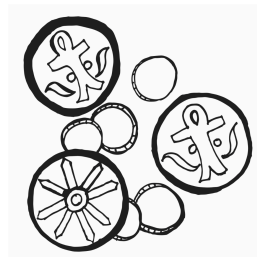

PAPER SHREDDING

Limit of three boxes per person. Documents will be shredded with advanced cross-cut technology that ensures comprehensive and secure document destruction. The shredded materials will then be provided to paper mills for recycling.

ELECTRONIC RECYCLING

Electronics Recycling is made possible with the support of Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency. Accepted Items include: Computers, Monitors, Laptops, Computer Peripherals (keyboards, electronic mouse/pointing devices), Small Scale Servers, Printer/Copy/Fax Machines, Digital/Video Cameras, Radios, Digital Music Devices, VHS/DVD Players, Video Games Consoles, Televisions (Cathode Ray Tube, Non CRTs), Cable/Satellite Receivers, Digital Converter Boxes, Cellphones, Office Phones, Phone Chargers, GPS or Navigation Devices and all wires or cables associated with these devices.
